WHEREAS, the use of the lower collection rate in arriving at the budget appropriation Reserve for Uncollected Taxes in the 2015 Municipal Budget would result in an unfair tax burden to the taxpayers of the Township of Willingboro; and

WHEREAS, if tax appeal judgments of the county tax board or the State tax court result in tax reductions for the previous fiscal year, the governing body of the municipality may elect to calculate the current year reserve for uncollected taxes by reducing the certified tax levy of the prior year by the amount of the adjustments resulting from those judgments; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Local Government Services, Department of Community Affairs will allow the Township of Willingboro to use the alternate collection rate for the year 2014 in calculating the budget appropriation Reserve for Uncollected Taxes in the 2015 Municipal Budget; and

WHEREAS, the prior year's collection rate without reducing the certified tax for county tax board or the State tax court appeals is 96.00% for 2014; and

WHEREAS, the prior year's collection rate with reducing the certified tax for county tax board or the State tax court appeals is 96.43% for 2014,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township of Willingboro will use the collection rate of 96.43% in calculating the budget appropriation Reserve for Uncollected Taxes in the 2015 Municipal Budget.
