#### RESOLUTION FOR EMERGENCY TEMPORARY BUDGET APPROPRIATION

April 21, 2015

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20 provides for emergency temporary appropriations necessary for the period prior to adoption of the budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township previously adopted a resolution authorizing adoption of a 2015 Temporary Budget (the "Temporary Budget"); and

WHEREAS, the total amount of all current fund appropriations in the Temporary Budget equals \$16,561,164.79; and

WHEREAS, the Temporary Budget appropriated \$52,825.00 to the Capital Improvement Fund; and

WHEREAS, an additional appropriation of \$652,825.00 to the Capital Improvement Fund (the "Additional CIF Appropriation") is required to provide for the period until the adoption of the 2015 budget; and

WHEREAS, the total temporary appropriations adopted in the year 2015 pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-19 and 40A:4-20, including the amount appropriated by this resolution shall total:

\$ 17,213,989.79

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Council of the Township of Willingboro, in the County of Burlington (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) that in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20, the Additional CIF Appropriation is hereby appropriated in the temporary budget;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** by the Council of the Township of Willingboro, in the County of Burlington, that the Additional CIF Appropriation shall be included under the correct heading in the 2015 budget when adopted; and

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED,** by the Council of the Township of Willingboro, in the County of Burlington that the aggregate amount of temporary appropriations for the line "Capital Improvement Fund", including the amount set forth in the Temporary Budget and the amount appropriated by this resolution, shall equal:

1.	Any matter which, by express provision of federal law, state statute or rule of court is rendered confidential or excluded from the public portion of the meeting.
2.	Any matter in which the release of information would impair the right to receive funds from the United States Government.
3.	Any material the disclosure of which constitutes and unwarranted invasion of privacy as set forth in N.J.S.A. 10:4-12b(3).
4.	Any Collective Bargaining Agreement or the terms and conditions which are proposed for inclusion in any Collective Bargaining Agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees.
5.	Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real estate with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds where it could adversely affect the public interest if discussions of such matters were disclosed.
6.	Any tactics and techniques utilized in protecting the safety and property of the public and any investigations of violations or possible violations of law.
7.	Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiations in which Township Council is or may become a party.
8.	Any matters falling within the attorney/client privilege to the extent that confidentiality is required for the attorney to exercise his/her ethical duties as a lawyer.

9.	Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment and other categories set forth in N.J.S.A. 10:4-12b(8).
10.	Any deliberations occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of specific civil penalty or the suspension of loss of a license or permit as set forth in N.J.S.A. 10:9-12b(9).
