
WHEREAS, funds are available for this purpose as indicated by the attached Treasurer's Certification.

We have tabulated the bids received on September 21, 2010, regarding the above-referenced project and find the apparent low bidder to be Lewandowski Construction Industries, LLC, in the amount of \$127,609.44. However, due to a clerical error Lewandowski Construction Industries, LLC, has requested that their bid be withdrawn (see the attached letter dated September 28, 2010). Our office takes no exception to their request, as it was our opinion that their bid was substantially lower than the engineer's estimate of cost for the project.

Because of Lewandowski Construction Industries, LLC request to withdraw, we find the second apparent lowest and responsible bidder to be Landberg Construction, LLC in the amount of \$186,195.00.

Therefore, in accordance with Local Public Contracts Law, NJSA 40A:11-1 et seq, the contract should be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, which appears to be Landberg Construction, LLC, 486 Clarkstown Road, Mays Landing NJ 08330 in the amount of \$186,195.00. A copy of the tabulation is enclosed for your review.

The award should be contingent upon approval of the Solicitor and monies being available.



Voluntary Separation Incentive Program

The Township of Willingboro has instituted a Voluntary Separation Incentive Program (VSIP) for any individual employed within the Police Department with 25 or more years of full time service with the Township who voluntarily elects to retire with a termination date on or before December 31, 2010.

CURRENT CONTRACT LANGUAGE

Under the terms of the current collective bargaining agreement between the Township of Willingboro and LESA, a "bargaining unit member who retires from the department after completing 25 years of full-time service with the Township of Willingboro shall be eligible to receive an annual payment for health insurance benefits including dental benefits in an amount equal to fifty (50%) of the total cost up to and including the husband and wife plan. The member will be responsible for the remaining fifty percent (50%) of the total cost of the plan. A member who elects to utilize the family plan will be responsible for the difference between that plan and the husband and wife plan." (Section 25.4)

VOLUNTARY SEPARATION INCENTIVE PROGRAM

For those individuals employed within the Police Department with 25 or more years of full time service with Willingboro Township who voluntarily elect to retire with a termination date on or before December 31, 2010, the Township will increase the annual payment for health insurance benefits, including dental benefits, to sixty-five percent (65%) of the total cost, up to and including the *family plan*. The member will be responsible for the remaining thirty-five percent (35%) of the total cost of the plan.

After ten years of payment at the sixty-five percent (65%) level, payment shall revert to an amount equal to fifty percent (50%) of the total cost up to and including the *husband and wife plan*. The member will be responsible for the remaining fifty percent (50%) of the total cost of the plan.

Under both the current contract language and the VSIP, any member may drop his or her Township coverage and obtain coverage through another health benefit plan. In this case the Township will make a direct payment to the health care plan not to exceed the above noted amount annually. If a member drops his or her Township coverage he or she may return at any time to the Township's plan.

Additionally, and under both the current contract language and the VSIP, in no case shall the Township's obligation extend beyond the age at which the member becomes Medicare eligible. If the spouse becomes Medicare eligible before the member, the member must defer to single coverage.

Voluntary Separation Incentive Program

In order for qualified individuals to be eligible to participate in the Voluntary Separation Incentive Program, the individual must voluntarily retire from the Police Department with a termination date on or before December 31, 2010.



This past September, it was my pleasure to announce a new grant program established by the Freeholders to assist municipalities with park development and improvement projects and preservation of locally important lands. The response to this new program was overwhelming with thirty six of the County's forty municipalities submitting grant applications to the Municipal Park Development Program.

As you know, the Freeholders allocated \$5 million for grants in 2010. We did not expect to be able to fund all applications received in the first year of the Program. As was stated in the program documents and at the grant workshop, the application process was competitive. A review committee reviewed and ranked the applications in accordance with the criteria identified in the Policy and Procedure Manual and then further refined the ranking by taking into account project schedule. Scores for applications with projects that had proposed start dates between December 2010 and March 2011 were left as is while points were deducted for projects with proposed start dates from April 2011 forward. In order to be able to fund more projects, no bonus funding was awarded.

I am very pleased to advise you that Willingboro Township will be receiving the maximum grant amount - \$250,000. At today's meeting of the Freeholder Board, a resolution was adopted authorizing execution of grant agreements with all successful candidates. A grant agreement along with other pertinent information will be mailed to you shortly.

Thank you very much for your participation in the Burlington County Municipal Park Development Program. We wish you every success with your project.

- _____ 8. Any matters falling within the attorney/client privilege to the extent that confidentiality is required for the attorney to exercise his/her ethical duties as a lawyer.


