SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work consists of completely removing the trees from the embankment and replacing the existing failed storm sewer headwall and pipe with a proposed 5' diameter drop manhole, along with new reinforced concrete pipe and headwall. The area around the headwall and embankments will be backfilled with Borrow Excavation, Zone 3 and stabilized with topsoil, fertilize, seed and stabilization matting to its original state. The embankment shall be further stabilized by installing Steel Sheet Piling and backfill with Borrow Excavation, Zone 3 at a maximum slope of 3H:1V. The area shall then be stabilized with topsoil, fertilize, seed and matting. This work will take place at the rear yard of 65 &67 Pageant Lane in the Township of Willingboro, Burlington County.

The proposed improvements are indicated on the plan enclosed in this packet. 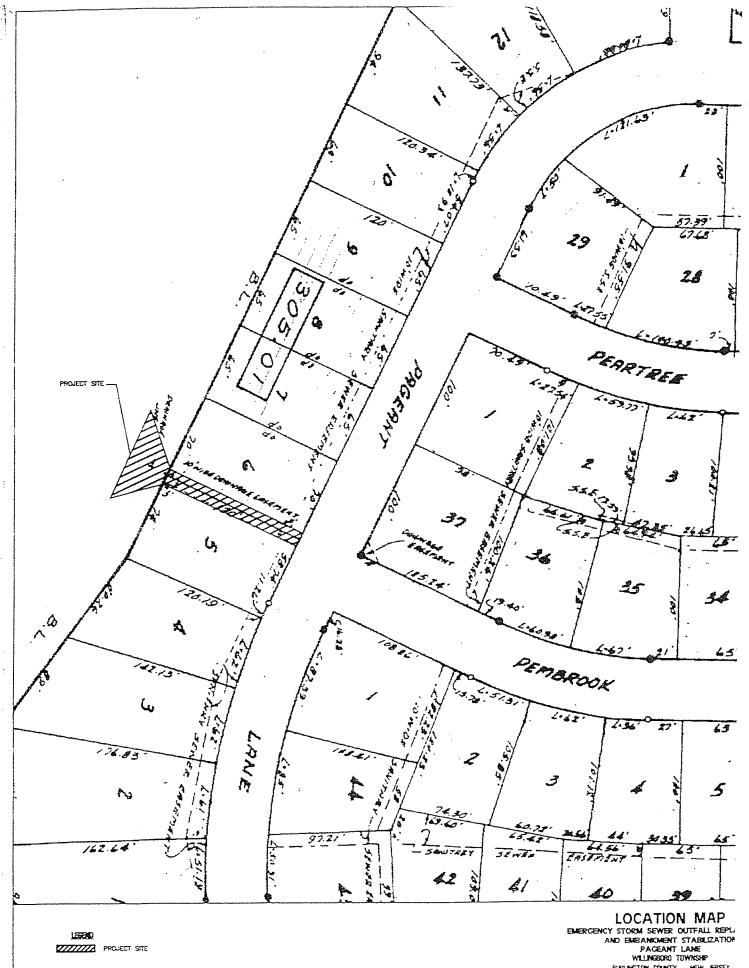

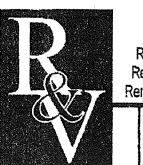

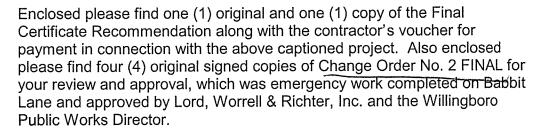
