WHEREAS, the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12, provides that an Executive Session, not open to the public, may be held for certain specified purposes when authorized by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Township Council of the Township of Willingboro to discuss in a session not open to the public certain matters relating to the item or items authorized by N.J.S.A. 10:4-12b and designated below:

- (7) Matters Relating to Litigation, Negotiations and the Attorney-Client Privilege: Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation in which the public body is, or may become a party. Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer.
- (8) Matters Relating to the Employment Relationship: Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance of promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body, unless all the individual employees or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed at a public meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Willingboro, assembled in public session on MPY 30, 1995, that an Executive Session closed to the public shall be held on MAY 30, 1995 at 9:06 p.m. in the Willingboro Township Municipal Complex, One Salem Road Willingboro, New Jersey, for the discussion of matters relating to the specific items designated above.

It is anticipated that the deliberations conducted in closed session may be disclosed to the public upon determination of the Township Council that the public interest will no longer be served by such confidentiality.

Resolution 1995 - 72

A Resolution of the Township Council of the Township of Willingboro providing for a Special Meeting of the Township Council where adequate notice may not have been provided pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act

Whereas, the Township Council of the Township of Willingboro is party to various tax appeals before the Burlington County Board of Taxation and the New Jersey Tax Court, and

Whereas, it has become apparent that the Tax Assessor for the Township of Willingboro has not prepared for the defense of those tax appeals and is not prepared to properly represent the Township of Willingboro with respect to those appeals or to supervise the operation of the Tax Assessor's Office, and

Whereas, it is necessary that the Township of Willingboro take immediate action to provide for the operation of the office of the Tax Assessor and the representation of the Township in the pending tax appeals, and

Whereas, the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq. requires that adequate notice be given to the public of a meeting, and

Whereas, the notice of the meeting was given at least 48 hours in advance of the meeting, as provided by the Open Public Meetings Act, but no Resolution was or could be adopted to amend the meeting schedule, since developments have taken place which could not be reasonably anticipated so that a meeting could have been scheduled in the normal course of procedure, and

Whereas, the delay that would result from not taking immediate action to designate an Acting Deputy Tax Assessor for the Township of Willingboro would harm the public interest as the Township would be unable to properly prepare for the pending tax appeals, and

Whereas, the Open Public Meetings Act, *N.J.S.A.* 10:4-9 does permit a meeting to be held, even where adequate notice has not been provided, upon the affirmative votes of three-quarters of the members present if the meeting is required in order to deal with matters of such urgency and importance that a delay for the purpose of providing adequate notice would be likely to result in substantial harm to the public interest and the meeting is limited to discussion of and acting with respect to such matters of urgency and importance and notice of the meeting is provided

as soon as possible following the calling of such meeting by posting written notice in a public place and by notifying the newspapers by telephone, telegram or by delivering a written notice to them, and

Whereas, the Township Clerk did, on June 1, 1995, post the required notice and provide notice to the newspapers required to receive notice that a Special meeting of the Township Council will be held on June 5, 1995, at 7:00 P.M., and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Willingboro, assembled this 5th day of June, 1995, that:

- A Special meeting of the Township Council shall be held on June 5, 1995, at 7:00
 P.M. at the Municipal Complex in Willingboro for the purpose of acting on a Resolution
 appointing an Acting Deputy Tax Assessor and providing for the operation of the office of the Tax
 Assessor and the representation of the Township in the pending tax appeals.
- 2. A copy of this Resolution shall be posted on the Bulletin Board in the Municipal Complex, shall be delivered to the Burlington County Times and shall be mailed to those entitled to receive such notice pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act.

Whereas, the 1995 tax appeals are currently pending before the Burlington County Board of Taxation and in the New Jersey Tax Court and it is essential that immediate action be taken to provide the for the appointment of a Certified Tax Assessor to serve as Acting Deputy Tax Assessor and to represent the Township of Willingboro with respect to all 1995 tax appeals,

Now, therefore Be It Resolved by the Township Council of the Township of Willingboro, assembled in public session this 5th day of June, 1995, that:

- 1. Carol Kerr, C.T.A. be and hereby is appointed as Acting Deputy Tax Assessor for the Township of Willingboro, effective immediately;

Carol Kerr, C.T.A., as Acting Deputy Tax Assessor for the Township of Willingboro and William John Kearns, Jr., as Solicitor for the Township of Willingboro are hereby authorized to represent the interests of the Township of Willingboro in any appeal in which the Township of Willingboro has an interest and William John Kearns, Jr. is hereby authorized to execute stipulations or settlements on behalf of the Township of Willingboro.
- 4. Carol Kerr, C.T.A., as Acting Deputy Tax Assessor is hereby authorized to exercise the duties of the Tax Assessor of the Township of Willingboro, effective immediately and continuing through June 30, 1995, and

Be It Further Resolved that certified copies of this Resolution shall be provided to Carol Kerr, C.T.A., to the Township Solicitor, to the Burlington County Board of Taxation and to the Township Manager for their information and attention.
