Dear Mr. Bonaparte:

As we discussed yesterday, during the ongoing construction activities in the Millbrook Park Section of town, we have encountered very unstable soils under the road bases. To date, the unstable soils have been encountered on Medford, Marboro and Mercator Lanes. The soils underlying the concrete road bases were such that, because of their clay and moisture content, they caused the concrete road bases to deteriorate and also become unstable. The result of this deterioration caused the roads to be unsuitable to pave.

The effect of the deterioration can be likened to that of pushing down on a water bed. With the application of a load being imposed on its surface, the underlying water pushes out to the side in a wave effect. In a roadbed, when a load is applied to unstable soils, the soils rut instead of bouncing back when the road is relieved of the load. The application of repeated loads on unstable soils causes them to become more unstable. Any asphalt installed under these conditions would immediately fail.

The deterioration of the concrete underlying the asphalt surface course is not uncommon, and has been a problem in the past with streets located in Millbrook. Buckingham, Hawthorne and Pennypacker Parks. The problems encountered are not usually to the extreme that we have encountered them on the above named streets because the underlying soils can, in most cases, be stabilized.

Under normal circumstances, the method for repairing this concrete, on a square yard basis (based on current contract prices, which are the lowest prices bid in recent years), would be as follows:

When the surface course was removed from Medford Lane, the underlying concrete base was completely deteriorated for the full length and width of the roadway. The underlying soils were also unstable. Because of this situation, we were forced to consider a more effective and economical means of addressing this situation. The traditional methods noted above would not have yielded good results and would have cost at least \$85,000.00 on this street alone. Having that information, we met with the contractor to examine various means of remediating the failed base course and stabilizing the underlying soils.

As a result of our meeting, we opted to employ lime stabilization on Medford Lane. Although we have not used this process in Willingboro Township before, the process has been used in many other places and is a method which is accepted by the New Jersey Department of Transportation. The lime stabilization involved grinding up the failed concrete and mixing it with approximately 40 lbs. of lime per square yard into the 8" of unstable soil underlying the concrete base. The purpose for adding this lime was to cause a chemical reaction which would remove the moisture from the clay subbase, thereby providing a suitable base to pave on. Mixing in the crushed concrete added the benefit of a recycled dense graded aggregate. The cost for utilizing this repair method was negotiated to \$3.85 per square yard, which is a very reasonable price considering the additional amount of work involved for the contractor. As a result of employing this method, the cost of performing the required subbase repairs was drastically reduced from the anticipated \$85,000.00 to \$49,000.00. Using lime stabilization, the cost per square yard for this repair is as follows:

As you can see, the cost of lime stabilization versus traditional base repair methods presents a significant savings, and the results have been good. The cost for employing traditional methods, as detailed above, would result in a cost of \$18.71 per square yard. The \$10.85 a square yard used to carry out the lime stabilization on Medford Lane resulted in a savings per square yard of approximately 58% and provided a better product.

The enclosed Change Order No. 1 has been completed to reflect the supplemental item of lime stabilization. This will result in a supplemental contract item, and appear as an increase of 5.8% original contract price. To date, this should be a sufficient quantity to address the current problem roads, however we can not know what the concrete and soils will be like until such time as the asphalt is removed from the road. This being said, the quantity reflected in this change order may increase. If that happens, the increase will be reflected in the change order adjusting the contract to as-built quantities after all work is completed.

- (7) Matters Relating to Litigation, Negotiations and the Attorney-Client Privilege: Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation in which the public body is, or may become a party. Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is required in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer.
- (8) Matters Relating to the Employment Relationship: Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance of promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body, unless all the individual employees or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed at a public meeting.

It is anticipated that the deliberations conducted in closed session may be disclosed to the public upon determination of the Township Council that the public interest will no longer be served by such confidentiality.
