RESOLUTION NO. 28 - 1993
A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A MEETING NOT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE NEW JERSEY OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12.

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Willingboro is subject to certain requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6, et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12, provides that an Executive Session, not open to the public, may be held for certain specified purposes when authorized by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Township Council of the Township of Willingboro to discuss in a session not open to the public certain matters relating to the item or items authorized by N.J.S.A. 10:4-12b and designated below:

- (1) Matters required by Law to be Confidential: Any matter which, by express provision of Federal law or State statute or rule of court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act.
- (2) Matters Where the Release of Information Would Impair the Right to Receive Funds: Any matter in which the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the Government of the United States.
- (3) Matters Involving Individual Privacy: Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodial, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal a family circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any individual, unless the individual concerned (or, in the case of a minor or incompetent, his guardian) shall request in writing that the same be disclosed publicly.
- (4) Matters Relating to Collective Bargaining Agreements: Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions, which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body.
- (5) Matters Relating to the Purchase, Lease of Acquisition of Real Property or the Investment of Public Funds: Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it would adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed.

RESOLUTION NO. 29 - 1993

WHEREAS, on December 15, 1971, the Highway Safety Act of 1971 was signed into law and Section 10 of this Act designates the Municipality to certify emergency service personnel and equipment of First Aid Squads; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Willingboro, assembled in public session this 2nd day of March, 1993, that the attached list of members of the Willingboro Emergency Squad, Inc. have been properly qualified to provide emergency medical service by meeting the requirements of Section 10 of the New Jersey Safety Act of 1971 (c. 351, P.L. 1971) and are hereby certified until March of 1994; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the attached inventory of equipment of the Willingboro Emergency Squad, Inc. be and is hereby certified to meet the requirements of said law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution be provided to the Willingboro Emergency Squad, Inc. and the New Jersey State First Aid Council, Inc. for their information and attention.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT between the Township of Willingboro and ARNOLD W. BARNETT, PE and LS

WHEREAS, the Township of Willingboro requires the services of a Licensed Professional Engineer; and

WHEREAS, Arnold W. Barnett is a licensed Professional Engineer authorized to practice in the State of New Jersey and is hereafter identified as the Engineer;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the Township of Willingboro and Arnold W. Barnett, P.E. & L.S., a licensed Professional Engineer of the State of New Jersey as follows:

- I. APPOINTMENT. Arnold W. Barnett, P.E. & L.S. is hereby appointed and retained as Engineer and Inspector relative to Van Sciver Parkway roadway project.
- II. TERM. This appointment shall continue until the matters assigned have been concluded or until the services have been determined to be no longer required by the Township Council.
- III. SERVICE. During the terms of this Agreement, the Engineer agrees to prvide engineering and inspection services.
 - IV. COMPENSATION.
 - 1. During the term of this Agreement, the Engineer shall be compensated in accordance with Resolution No. 30 1993.
 - V. EQUAL OPPORTUNITY.
 - 1. In consideration of the execution of this Agreement, the Engineer shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, religion, color, sex, marital status or national origin. The Special Counsel shall comply with the New Jersey Law Against Discrimination, N.J.S.A. 10:5-1 et seq. and all other applicable Federal and New Jersey statutes of a similar nature.
 - 2. The attention of the Engineer is particularly drawn to the affirmative action provisions of the New Jersey Law Against Discrimination as set forth in N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 and the applicable regulations thereunder. The Engineer shall execute such additional documents as may be required of a person, partnership, or corporation doing business in the public sector within the State of New Jersey and shall comply with the rules and regulations relating thereto.
- VI. MANDATORY AFFIRMATIVE ACTION LANGUAGE REQUIRED IN ALL CONTRACTS WITH A PUBLIC AGENCY IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY. In accordance with the requirements of P.L. 1975, C. 127, and of N.J.A.C. 17:27, during the performance of this contract, the contractor agrees as follows:

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status or sex. The contractor or subcontractor agrees to inform in writing appropriate recruitment agencies, in the area, including employment agencies, placement bureaus, colleges, universities, labor unions, that it does not discriminate on the basis of age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status or sex, and that it will discontinue the use of any recruitment agency which engages in direct or indirect discriminatory practices.


