


RESOLUTION NO. 27 - 1993

WHEREAS, Willingboro Township Council has determined that the Willingboro Municipal Drug Alliance should be recognized as an official function of the Township of Willingboro;



RESOLUTION NO. 28 - 1993

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A MEETING NOT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE NEW JERSEY OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12.

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Willingboro is subject to certain requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6, et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12, provides that an Executive Session, not open to the public, may be held for certain specified purposes when authorized by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the Township Council of the Township of Willingboro to discuss in a session not open to the public certain matters relating to the item or items authorized by N.J.S.A. 10:4-12b and designated below:

- _____ (1) Matters required by Law to be Confidential: Any matter which, by express provision of Federal law or State statute or rule of court shall be rendered confidential or excluded from the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act.
- _____ (2) Matters Where the Release of Information Would Impair the Right to Receive Funds: Any matter in which the release of information would impair a right to receive funds from the Government of the United States.
- _____ (3) Matters Involving Individual Privacy: Any material the disclosure of which constitutes an unwarranted invasion of individual privacy such as any records, data, reports, recommendations, or other personal material of any educational, training, social service, medical, health, custodial, child protection, rehabilitation, legal defense, welfare, housing, relocation, insurance and similar program or institution operated by a public body pertaining to any specific individual admitted to or served by such institution or program, including but not limited to information relative to the individual's personal a family circumstances, and any material pertaining to admission, discharge, treatment, progress or condition of any individual, unless the individual concerned (or, in the case of a minor or incompetent, his guardian) shall request in writing that the same be disclosed publicly.
- _____ (4) Matters Relating to Collective Bargaining Agreements: Any collective bargaining agreement, or the terms and conditions, which are proposed for inclusion in any collective bargaining agreement, including the negotiation of the terms and conditions thereof with employees or representatives of employees of the public body.
- _____ (5) Matters Relating to the Purchase, Lease or Acquisition of Real Property or the Investment of Public Funds: Any matter involving the purchase, lease or acquisition of real property with public funds, the setting of banking rates or investment of public funds, where it would adversely affect the public interest if discussion of such matters were disclosed.

RESOLUTION NO. 29 - 1993

WHEREAS, on December 15, 1971, the Highway Safety Act of 1971 was signed into law and Section 10 of this Act designates the Municipality to certify emergency service personnel and equipment of First Aid Squads; and

WHEREAS, certification must be renewed for a one year period in compliance with the Highway Safety Act, said certification to be effective March 15, 1993 through March 15, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Willingboro Emergency Squad, Inc. of Willingboro Township has qualified under this Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Willingboro, assembled in public session this 2nd day of March, 1993, that the attached list of members of the Willingboro Emergency Squad, Inc. have been properly qualified to provide emergency medical service by meeting the requirements of Section 10 of the New Jersey Safety Act of 1971 (c. 351, P.L. 1971) and are hereby certified until March of 1994; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the attached inventory of equipment of the Willingboro Emergency Squad, Inc. be and is hereby certified to meet the requirements of said law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution be provided to the Willingboro Emergency Squad, Inc. and the New Jersey State First Aid Council, Inc. for their information and attention.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT
between the Township of Willingboro
and ARNOLD W. BARNETT, PE and LS

WHEREAS, the Township of Willingboro requires the services of a Licensed Professional Engineer; and

WHEREAS, Arnold W. Barnett is a licensed Professional Engineer authorized to practice in the State of New Jersey and is hereafter identified as the Engineer;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the Township of Willingboro and Arnold W. Barnett, P.E. & L.S., a licensed Professional Engineer of the State of New Jersey as follows:

I. APPOINTMENT. Arnold W. Barnett, P.E. & L.S. is hereby appointed and retained as Engineer and Inspector relative to Van Sciver Parkway roadway project.

II. TERM. This appointment shall continue until the matters assigned have been concluded or until the services have been determined to be no longer required by the Township Council.

III. SERVICE. During the terms of this Agreement, the Engineer agrees to provide engineering and inspection services.

IV. COMPENSATION.

1. During the term of this Agreement, the Engineer shall be compensated in accordance with Resolution No. 30 - 1993.

V. EQUAL OPPORTUNITY.

1. In consideration of the execution of this Agreement, the Engineer shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, religion, color, sex, marital status or national origin. The Special Counsel shall comply with the New Jersey Law Against Discrimination, N.J.S.A. 10:5-1 et seq. and all other applicable Federal and New Jersey statutes of a similar nature.

2. The attention of the Engineer is particularly drawn to the affirmative action provisions of the New Jersey Law Against Discrimination as set forth in N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 and the applicable regulations thereunder. The Engineer shall execute such additional documents as may be required of a person, partnership, or corporation doing business in the public sector within the State of New Jersey and shall comply with the rules and regulations relating thereto.

VI. MANDATORY AFFIRMATIVE ACTION LANGUAGE REQUIRED IN ALL CONTRACTS WITH A PUBLIC AGENCY IN THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY. In accordance with the requirements of P.L. 1975, C. 127, and of N.J.A.C. 17:27, during the performance of this contract, the contractor agrees as follows:

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status or sex. The contractor will take affirmative action to ensure that such applicants are recruited and employed, and that employees are treated, during employment, without regard to their age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status or sex. The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by or on behalf of the contractor, state that all qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to age, race, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status, or sex;

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, will send to each labor union or representative or workers with which it has a collective bargaining agreement or other contract or understanding, a notice, to be provided by the agency contracting officer advising the labor union or workers' representative, of the contractor's commitments under this act and shall post copies of this notice in conspicuous places available to employees and applicants for employment.

The contractor or subcontractor, where applicable, agrees to comply with the regulations promulgated by the Treasurer of the State of New Jersey, pursuant to P.L. 1975, c.127, as amended and supplemented from time to time.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to attempt in good faith to employ minority and female workers consistent with the applicable county employment goals prescribed by N.J.A.C 17:27-5.2 promulgated by the Treasurer of the State of New Jersey, pursuant to P.L. 1975, c.127, as amended and supplemented from time to time or in accordance with a binding determination of the applicable county employment goals determined by the Affirmative Action Office pursuant to N.J.A.C. 17:27-5.2 promulgated by the Treasurer of the State of New Jersey, pursuant to P.L. 1975, c.127, as amended and supplemented from time to time.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to inform in writing appropriate recruitment agencies, in the area, including employment agencies, placement bureaus, colleges, universities, labor unions, that it does not discriminate on the basis of age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status or sex, and that it will discontinue the use of any recruitment agency which engages in direct or indirect discriminatory practices.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to revise any of its testing procedures, if necessary, to assure that all personnel testing conforms with the principles of job-related testing, as established by the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey and as established by applicable federal law and applicable federal court decisions.

The contractor or subcontractor agrees to review all procedures relating to transfer, upgrading, downgrading and layoff to ensure that all such actions are taken without regard to age, creed, color, national origin, ancestry, marital status or sex, and conform with the applicable employment goals, consistent with the statutes and court decisions of the State of New Jersey and applicable federal law and applicable federal court decisions.

The contractor and its subcontractor shall furnish such reports or other documents to the Affirmative Action Office, in the New Jersey Department of the Treasury, as may be requested by the office from time to time in order to carry out the purpose of these regulations, and public agencies shall furnish such information as may be requested by the Affirmative Action Office for conducting a compliance investigation pursuant to Subchapter 10 of the Administrative Code(N.J.A.C.17:27).

VII. NEW JERSEY LAW. This Agreement shall be governed by and in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.

VIII. MODIFICATION. No modification of this Agreement shall be valid or binding unless the modification shall be in writing and executed by the Township of Willingboro and the Engineer.

IX. NO WAIVER. No waiver of any term, provision or condition contained in this Agreement, or any breach of any such term, provision or condition shall constitute a waiver of any subsequent breach of such term, provision or condition by either party, or justify or authorize the non-observance on any other occasion of the same or any other term, provision or condition of this Agreement by either party.

X. CAPTIONS. The captions or the paragraph headings contained in this Agreement are solely for purposes of convenience and shall not be deemed part of this Agreement for the purpose of construing the meaning thereof or for any other purpose.

XI. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. This instrument contains the entire Agreement of the Parties hereto and may not be amended, modified, released or discharged, in whole or in part, except as specifically provided herein or in an instrument in writing executed by the parties hereto.

XII. AMENDMENTS. The parties hereto may, by mutual agreement, change the scope of services or the amount of compensation set forth in this Agreement.

WHEREAS, Section 21-9.12 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Willingboro provides for the abatement of certain conditions, and Section 21-9.13 provides that the cost of any abatement shall become a lien against real property; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Inspections has cited several properties and has imposed fines and expenses of repair on those properties as per the attached list; and


WHEREAS, Section 21-9.13 further provides that the Township Council must, by Resolution, approve the expenses and costs and that they shall thereafter become a lien against the properties listed and shall be collectible as provided by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Willingboro, assembled in public session this 7th day of April, 1993, that the fines and expenses certified by the Director of Inspections and listed on the attached schedule are hereby approved and certified to the Tax Collector of the Township of Willingboro as liens against the specific properties listed and to draw interest as tax liens as provided by law.


