RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF WILLINGBORO TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MUNICIBID.COM FOR INTERNET AUCTIONEEING SERVICES TO SELL TOWNSHIP SURPLUS PROPERTY- STATE CONTRACT NUMBER T-2581

WHEREAS, there is a need to sell surplus property belonging to the Township of Willingboro as:

- a. The surplus personal property is no longer needed for public use.
- b. The sale will be online and the address of the auction site.
- c. The sale is being conducted pursuant to Local Finance Notice 2008-9 and N.J.S.A. 40A:11-36, authorizing the sale;
- d. For those items that are part of the Township of Willingboro's fixed asset inventory, the attached description of items in this resolution include information that sufficiently identifies the item and provides an audit trail (i.e., inventory or serial number).
- e. For items not in the fixed asset inventory, this resolution provides a general attached list with description sufficient to inform the public of the item being sold.
- f. The attached listing for any motorized vehicle that is titled in the name of the Township of Willingboro includes the vehicle identification number (VIN) shown on the title. The Township of Willingboro complies with applicable statutes regarding abandoned property, confiscated vehicles, etc.
- g. The terms and conditions of the agreement entered into with Municibid.com are available on the vendor's website and available in the Willingboro Township Clerk's office.

WHEREAS, it is desirous to authorize Municibid.com to provide the internet auctioneering services for the sale of the surplus property online at the address of the auction site; and

WHEREAS, Municibid.com are under current New Jersey State Contract T-2581 expiring April 30, 2022;

WHEREAS, the documentation from Municibid.com is attached and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the funds the Township of Willingboro receives from the sales of the surplus property will be posed as reserve for sale of municipal assets.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Council of the Township of Willingboro, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey assembled in public session the January 1, 2022, authorizes Municibid.com to provide auctioneering services from the sale of surplus property under State Contract Number T-2581 pursuant to the documentation attached and incorporated herein by reference.

I. Purpose & Intent

The purpose of this Blanket P.O. is to provide Distribution and Support Services (DSS), of the Department of the Treasury, with a Vendor {Contractor} to provide internet based auction services to sell surplus property.

II. Award Method

This Blanket P.O. was awarded to Municibid. The base term of this Blanket P.O. is for three (3) years with an option to be extended up to two (2) years with no single extension exceeding one (1) year.

III. Directions for Use of Blanket P.O.

1. State Agencies

Unless approved otherwise in writing by the Division of Purchase and Property, State Agencies requiring the services provided by this Blanket P.O. must direct all requests through the appropriate Division of the Department of the Treasury.

- A. Surplus Property- DSS;
- B. Real Estate/ Land- Division of Property and Management Construction; and
- C. Tax Seized Assets-Division of Taxation.

All checks received by the State Agencies from winning Auction Bidders must be made out to the "Treasurer, State of New Jersey", unless approved otherwise in writing by the

Division of Purchase and Property, and be deposited in accordance with all applicable State rules and regulations.

2. Cooperative Purchasing Partners

This Blanket P.O. shall be extended to the State's Cooperative Purchasing Partners. The Vendor {Contractor} shall deal directly with each State Cooperative Purchasing Partner and assist that partner to utilize the Auction Service Site, including how to register.
