



## TOP TEN BULK PICK UP/RUBBISH COLLECTION REMINDERS

Bulk Pick-Up occurs during the last full week of every month and is by appointment only. The appointment deadline is the Thursday before the collection week. Appointments must be made via the Willingboro Connect app (preference) or by calling 609-877-2200, ext. 1051 or 1107.

1. Place Trash/Recycling containers at curbside (near the driveway) by 7:00 AM of collection day, but **no earlier than sunset** of the evening prior to collection day. **TRASH SHOULD NEVER BE PLACED OUT ON WEEKENDS OR BETWEEN COLLECTION DAYS.**
2. Normal household trash must be placed in **PROVIDED TOWNSHIP CONTAINERS** with lids closed and attached. **NEVER PLACE TRASH IN RECYCLING CARTS!**
3. All bulk items must be disassembled and tied into bundles, except in cases where disassembly is not practical, such as a SOFA, MATTRESS, and BOXSPRING, etc. Carpeting must be no longer than four feet in length and must be rolled and tied and no more than five bundles per collection day. Mattresses and box springs must be wrapped/enclosed in a plastic cover. These items are considered BULK (see item #7).
4. Residents are advised that the **GARBAGE CONTRACTOR IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REMOVAL OF:** leaves\*\*, cars, automotive parts, tires, building materials, cardboard, fences, stones, or dirt. \*\*Call the Public Works Department at 609-877-2200, ext. 1051 or 1107 for the leaf collection schedule.
5. **BRANCHES** must be securely bundled, tied in two places so they can easily be handled. The diameter of any one branch cannot exceed six inches (6") and branches may be no longer than three feet (3'). Bundles are to be more than 30 lbs. in weight. Branches can be placed in cart or brought to the Resource Recovery Complex at 609-499-5200.
6. **ALL METAL ITEMS/APPLIANCES** – All items must be placed at the curb, on Tuesday evening after 8:00 PM or at sunset. Call 609-877-2200, ext. 1051 or 1107 by 2:00 pm on Tuesdays. Leave your address and the name of the item placed at the curb and it will be put on the metal list for Wednesday collection.
7. **BULKY SOLID WASTE** – Items such as carpet, wood, wooden framed upholstered furniture, mattresses, toilets, small quantities of homeowner renovation materials, etc. should be placed on the curb on your scheduled BULK collection day. Mattresses and box springs must be enclosed in a plastic cover. (Only TWO BULK ITEMS PER PICK UP FOR BULK PICK UP) **DO NOT PLACE AT CURB UNTIL THE NIGHT BEFORE YOUR SCHEDULED PICK UP.**

8. All clean **CARDBOARD** boxes (including moving boxes) along with newspaper, glass and plastic should be placed in your recycling cart on scheduled recycling days only. General recycling questions answered at 609-267-6889. Items may also be taken to the Public Works Yard at 25 Industrial Drive. **Download the Recycle Coach app for updates, alerts, and schedules.**
9. **Computers and TVs WILL NOT BE PICKED UP!** TVs or Computers should NEVER be placed at the curb. If you buy a new TV, check with the retailer to see if they will take your old one. Goodwill Donation Center will take non-working TVs and computers. TVs and computers may also be taken to the Burlington County Recycling Center at 609-499-1001 or visit <https://co.burlington.nj.us/345/Recycling>
10. Tires will not be picked up. For more information on tire disposal contact Ray's Tire Service 856-461-6002 or call the County Solid Waste Complex (Landfill) at 609-499-5200.
